I understand that the preschool program staff will be doing daily health checks, as required by Title 22 section 101226. Staff members are required to report any communicable disease and/or unusual marks, burns, bruises, etc. that they may observe, or any other indications of possible child abuse or neglect to the appropriate agencies per Section 1166 of the Penal code.

Regulation in Title 22, California Administration Code requires that parents are informed of the following: Code 101200 - The Department of Social Services has the authority to interview children or staff and to inspect and audit childcare records without prior consent. The licensee shall make provisions for a private interview with any child or staff member; and or examinations of all records relating to the operation of the childcare center. The Department of Social Services has the authority to observe the physical condition of a child, including conditions that could indicate abuse, neglect or inappropriate placement.
